EAGLE RARE

Eagle Rare Bourbon Whiskey is masterfully crafted and carefully aged for no less than ten years. Every barrel is discriminately selected to offer consistent flavor but with a seemingly individual personality. Eagle Rare is a bourbon that lives up to its name with its lofty, distinctive taste experience.

The nose is complex, with aromas of toffee, hints of orange peel, herbs, honey, leather and oak. The taste is bold, dry and delicate with notes of candied almonds and very rich cocoa. The finish is dry and lingering.

BLANTON'S SINGLE BARREL

Albert Bacon Blanton was the President of Buffalo Trace Distillery from 1921-1952. During that period Colonel Blanton created his very special and limited supply of bourbon - his private reserve - handpicked and stored in what now is known as the famous Warehouse H. Although Colonel Blanton died in the spring of 1959, his legacy lives. Introduced in 1984, Blanton's namesake bourbon was the first ever Single Barrel Bourbon sold commercially. The Single Barrel Bourbon is the first of its kind.

A deep, satisfying nose of nutmeg and spices. Powerful dry vanilla notes in harmony with hints of honey amid strong caramel and corn. A medium finish composed of returning corn and nutmeg flavors.

Lux Row's limited-release double barrel bourbon was bottled to commemorate the grand opening of Lux Row Distillers.

Like the name suggests, the bourbon was aged in two different barrels - for 12 years each - allowing for an extra-aged expression highlighted by notes of caramel, vanilla, oak and tobacco. Even the proof of 118.4 is a nod to the distillery, as they opened their doors in April 2018.

Made with their unique "Sinatra Barrels" that have deep grooves specially carved into their staves to expose the whiskey to extra layers of toasted oak. This added exposure imparts a rich amber color, bold character, and pleasant smokiness, punctuated by an incredibly smooth vanilla finish. Much like Frank, this Tennessee Whiskey is one of a kind.



WHISTLE PIG DOUBLE MALT 18 YR

WhistlePig Double Malt Rye is their oldest Rye, patiently mellowed for 18 years. As a nod to the farmers, Double Malt Rye is crafted from a mash bill of Rye, Malted Rye and Malted Barley. These grains unite in a show-stopping Rye Whiskey that stretches far and wide across the flavor spectrum. Its base of 79% Rye delivers bold, peppery spice, while 15% Malted Rye adds soft, floral and earthy character. A final 6% of malted barley brings rich, sweet, toasted notes.

To take the expansive palate of WhistlePig Double Malt even further the 4th Edition is finished in Spanish PX Sherry Casks.

To sip Barrel Proof is to experience Bourbon in its purest form: uncut, straight from the barrel, and without chill filtering. Each bottle has its own unique age statement, proof, and batch number allowing for subtle nuances from batch to batch; but the nose, taste, and finish are pure Elijah Craig.

This high proof, Bottled-in-Bond Bourbon was named for Henry McKenna, the Irish immigrant who adapted his family's whiskey recipe to work with the grains he found in Kentucky. Henry McKenna is one of the longest aged Bottled-in-Bond whiskeys available today, resting in the barrel through 40 Kentucky seasons. Critics agree that this is perfectly balanced Bourbon.

SAZERAC RYE



The One and Only New Orleans Original. Sazerac Rye Whiskey symbolizes the tradition and history of New Orleans. Rye Whiskey dates back to the 1800's, around the time when saloons, veiled as Coffee Houses, began lining the streets of New Orleans.

It was at the Sazerac Coffee House on Royal Street where local patrons were served toddies made with Rye Whiskey and Peychaud's Bitters. The libation became known as the "Sazerac" and America's first branded cocktail was born. This is the whiskey that started it all.

Finished in Spanish Oloroso Sherry-Dark Rum Casks Aged 7 Years 6 Months. Mash Bill of 75% Corn, 20% Rye, 5% Malted Barley. Only 4,014 bottles made. Distilled in Kentucky; apart of Batch 26.



FOUR GATE ANDALUSIA KEY RYE

Straight Rye Whiskey Finished in Spanish Oloroso Sherry-Dark Rum Casks aged 7 Years. Mash Bill of 95% Rye, 5% Malted Barley. Only 3,735 bottles made. Distilled in Indiana; apart of Batch 25.



FG JAPANESE MIZUNARA OAK

The Majestic Wood Series features age-stated Kentucky Straight Bourbon Whiskey finished in exotic wood casks from around the world. The first offering of the series is a 7 year, 6 month Kentucky Straight Bourbon finished in rare casks made from Japanese Mizunara Oak. Kentucky Straight Bourbon Whiskey finished in Rare Japanese Mizunara Oak Barrels Mash Bill: 75% Corn, 20% Rye, 5% Malted Barley Aged at least 7 Years 6 months.



FOUR GATE KELVIN COLLAB V



The Kelvin Collaboration is the company's annual signature release. It is released each year shortly before the Kentucky Derby in early May. The company is always sure to put their best foot forward with this release. The Kelvin Collaboration V is a blend of three Kentucky Straight Bourbons. A 7-year bourbon, an 8-year bourbon of the same mash bill, and a 9-year bourbon. The whiskey was then finished in Australian Mariposa Sherry and Añejo Dark Rum casks.



FOUR GATE KELVIN SIXTY



Kelvin Cooperage was founded in Glasgow, Scotland in 1963 and is now based in Louisville, KY. Since the founding of Four Gate Whiskey Company in 2018, Kelvin Cooperage has been instrumental in providing advice, guidance, and expertly crafted and sourced barrels of all kinds.

To commemorate the occasion, Four Gate Whiskey Company selected 8-year-old barrels of Kentucky straight Bourbon Whiskey and re-barreled them in new toasted and charred casks from Kelvin Cooperage. The resulting double-oaked bourbon is dark, full-bodied, and rich in flavor.



FOUR GATE RYE DOWNUNDER



Distilled in Indiana from a mash bill of 95% rye and 5% malted barley, this is the 16th release by Four Gate. The same 7-year-old rye whiskey was released unfinished in 2020. This time it was finished in Apera sherry casks from Australia.
