### OLD FORESTER 1924

The Whiskey Row Series' 1924 10 – Year – Old is a limited annual release celebrating another milestone in Old Forester's storied history. During Prohibition, more than 200 distilleries were forced to close. Old Forester, however, continued operations because the federal government issued us one of six medicinal licenses, P-3. In 1924, Old Forester acquired barrels from closed distillers, with different mash bills, and bottled that liquid as Old Forester. This release commemorates that moment in time.

# BLANTON'S SINGLE BARREL

Albert Bacon Blanton was the President of Buffalo Trace Distillery from 1921-1952. During that period Colonel Blanton created his very special and limited supply of bourbon - his private reserve - handpicked and stored in what now is known as the famous Warehouse H. Although Colonel Blanton died in the spring of 1959, his legacy lives. Introduced in 1984, Blanton's namesake bourbon was the first ever Single Barrel Bourbon sold commercially. The Single Barrel Bourbon is the first of its kind.

A deep, satisfying nose of nutmeg and spices. Powerful dry vanilla notes in harmony with hints of honey amid strong caramel and corn. A medium finish composed of returning corn and nutmeg flavors.

Caribou Crossing Single Barrel is a premium Canadian whisky known as the first of its kind, produced by Sazerac and bottled at Buffalo Trace, often compared to Blanton's bourbon due to its single-barrel selection process, distinctive caribou stopper, and rich notes of vanilla, caramel, and spice, offering a smooth, complex, and collectible spirit with aromas of honey and orange, and a balanced, slightly spicy finish.

## STAGG JR.

## EAGLE RARE

Eagle Rare Bourbon Whiskey is masterfully crafted and carefully aged for no less than ten years. For the 2024 Master's Collection release, Master Distiller Elizabeth McCall experimented with finishing Woodford Reserve in Madeira barrels— creating uniquely fruit-forward whiskies. Hailing from the Madeira islands off the coast of Portugal, the Madeira barrels are rich with dried fruit, spice, and nutty flavors from the fortified wine they once held. To further enhance the flavors of the Madeira-finished whiskies, they blended them with Woodford's fruit-forward Kentucky Straight Wheat Whiskey. Together, this blend elevates the expansive fruit and floral notes found in our Wheat Whiskey to create this year's Master Collection Presentation: Woodford Reserve Madeira Finish Blend.

WhistlePig Double Malt Rye is their oldest Rye, patiently mellowed for 18 years. As a nod to the farmers, Double Malt Rye is crafted from a mash bill of Rye, Malted Rye and Malted Barley. These grains unite in a show-stopping Rye Whiskey that stretches far and wide across the flavor spectrum. Its base of 79% Rye delivers bold, peppery spice, while 15% Malted Rye adds soft, floral and earthy character. A final 6% of malted barley brings rich, sweet, toasted notes.

To take the expansive palate of WhistlePig Double Malt even further the 4th Edition is finished in Spanish PX Sherry Casks.
